How we will put safety and security in order:

- more police officers, higher police salaries and paid police training
- more police powers, such as stop-and-search zones in order to seize more weapons
- anonymous witnesses, so people are not afraid to testify against criminals
- deportation of foreign citizens who commit serious crimes in Sweden
- tougher sentencing, scrapping non-cumulative sentencing and abolishing reduced sentences for criminals over the age of 18

How we will put employment in order:

- lower taxes on work, particularly for low and middle incomes
- benefits cap so it always pays to work
- require action by claimants in return for benefits
- lower taxes on pensions – it should pay to have worked
- national census to combat criminality and exclusion

How we will put the economy in order:

- no to property tax and other duties on households
- lower taxes on petrol and diesel
- lower taxes on savings (investment savings accounts)
- better conditions and less red tape for businesses
- bring the public finances under control

How we will put the climate and energy supply in order:

- investment in new nuclear power – yes to fossil-free energy, no to Russian gas and oil
- clean transport through electric power and charging infrastructure
- improved opportunities for industry to restructure and export with a minimal climate footprint
- increase to international climate aid
- international collaborations, particularly within the EU

How we will put integration in order:

- tighten up on immigration and expel those who do not have permission to be in Sweden
- clear work-first principle and tough requirements to learn Swedish
- language screening at children's healthcare centres and mandatory language preschool
- ban on marriage between cousins and tougher sentencing for honour-related violence and oppression
- ban on clan courts, and a dedicated clan unit within the police

How we will put schools in order:

- focus on measurable knowledge and more hours of teaching
- clearer powers for teachers and headteachers to maintain order and discipline
- protect the free choice of schools, but combat unreliable providers and cheating
- central marking of national exams to combat grade inflation
- stop affirmative action and forced busing of children to poorly performing schools
