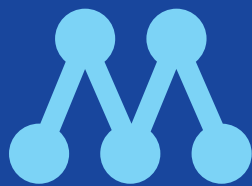




For a *fairer*

A Sweden where *hard work* effort should be rewarded, crime is punished and society works when you need support.

More left of your salary. More for your family and free time.

Moderaterna will lower the tax on work and make it more profitable to work.

- We have reduced tax by SEK 5 000 a month for a regular family with children – and we want to reduce it by as much again
- Improved pension for anyone who has worked their whole working life
- A strict welfare policy with a benefits cap – work should pay off, fraud and waste should be stopped

Criminals should be inside so that you can be outside.

We are on the side of crime victims, stop gang violence and throttle the criminal economy.

- Fatal shootings have halved and gang criminals who are not Swedish citizens are now being expelled
- More police and cameras – harsher penalties and an end to the bulk discount
- Stop the recruitment of children by gangs and throttle the criminal economy
- Violence against women should be met with the same force as gang violence



Each *tax krona wasted* is less healthcare, education and security.

Healthcare to trust. Not wait for.

You should be given the care you need in the right time.
This is a part of the social contract.

- We have increased the resources for the welfare system every year – and this will continue
- Compensation liability for healthcare providers that fail to comply with the care guarantee
- Health care within 30 days – and care elsewhere if waiting times are too long.
- Language proficiency requirements in elderly care
- Cheaper dental care for seniors

Strong economy. More jobs.

Only a strong economy can support the welfare system of the future.

- Sweden will have the highest standard of living in the EU within ten years
- More jobs in more companies – lower taxes and simpler rules
- Good order in the economy – strong public finances and responsible use of taxpayers' money
- Major investments in defence, nuclear power, infrastructure, education and social care

We get things done

- and there is more to do

Sweden's strength is the social contract. That if you do your bit, you know that society will be there for you when you need it. But cracks have appeared in the social contract. This shows when you toil at work and still barely make ends meet, when criminals live at the expense of others and when someone who has worked their entire life is forced to wait for months for an operation. That is not fair. And that is what we have tackled.

Sweden is on the right track – this shows in your everyday life

Since Moderaterna formed the government:

- Lowered taxes – a family with children keeps SEK 5 000 more per month
- Retired couples keep SEK 2 200 more per month
- Expulsion of gang criminals who are not Swedish citizens
- Fatal shootings halved and record numbers of frontline police officers
- Lower taxes on food, electricity, fuel and ISAs
- Health care waiting lists 30% shorter (except in Stockholm, where S are in power)
- Introduced a language proficiency requirement in elderly care
- Sweden a full member of NATO

We are not done

Moderaterna's goal is that living standards in Sweden will be the highest in the EU in ten years – a country where hard work pays off even more, gang violence is a thing of the past and health care and education work for everyone.
